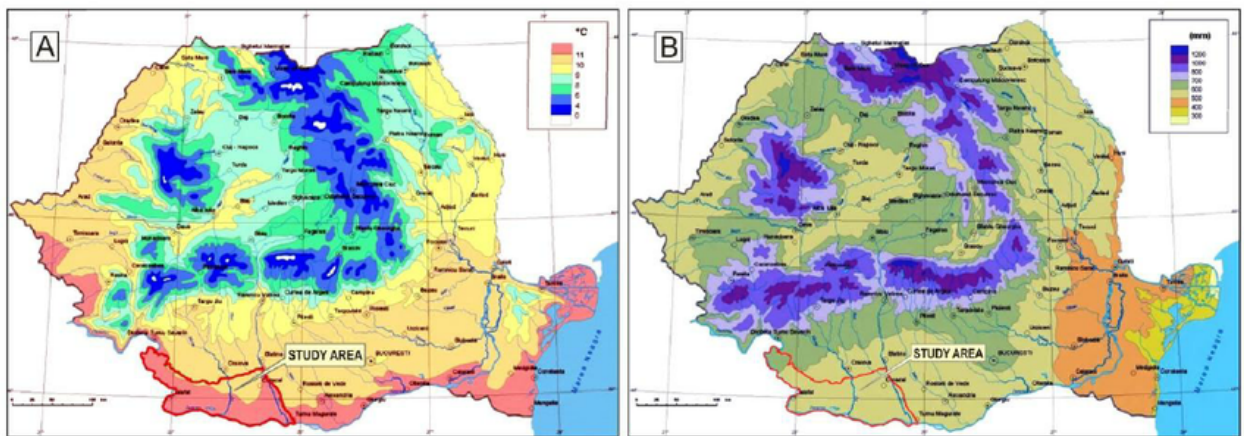


About how weather conditions affect life on the planet and in Romania

- Romania has a relatively mild climate, with average temperatures but there are some cases of weather conditions that affected Romania:
 - On 17th of June 2021 a dangerous cyclone brought horrible weather to Romania. It was announced to be 31 degrees Celsius but there were torrential storms;

 - The Vlad family lives in the Romanian Carpathians. This family says that they are now facing the risk of losing their family farm, their livestock and their traditional family occupation due to increasing temperatures, droughts and lack of water in their region. The family has also observed changes in the seasons. It is now common for temperatures in February to rise up and then to drop again to sub-zero with snow in March. Because of this process corn and potatoes are no longer available.
