

5 ENVIRONMENTAL PROPOSALS FOR MY HEADMASTER

IMPLEMENTATION OF RECYCLING PROGRAMMES:



I think it would be a good idea to set up a recycling system in the school, with separate bins for paper, plastic, glass and other recyclable materials. Organise awareness campaigns to educate students and staff about the importance of recycling and how to do it correctly.





IMPLEMENTATION OF A COMPOSTING PROGRAMME:

The school should implement a composting programme, where organic waste from the cafeteria and other areas could be collected and turned into compost.

This compost could then be used in the school garden, thus closing the nutrient cycle and reducing the amount of waste sent to landfills.

The school should also organise workshops and activities on how to compost correctly and the environmental benefits of doing so.







REDUCTION OF PLASTIC CONSUMPTION:

I propose measures to reduce single-use plastic waste, such as eliminating plastic straws, providing refillable water fountains instead of plastic bottles, and promoting reusable containers for lunches and snacks.

The school should organise workshops on eco-friendly alternatives to plastic and how to reduce waste in general.







CREATION OF A SCHOOL GARDEN OR ORCHARD:

I suggest creating a green space where students can learn about sustainable agriculture and the importance of biodiversity.

A school garden or orchard will not only improve the school environment, but it can also be used for educational activities and science projects.



PROMOTION OF SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORT:

I suggest incentives to encourage students and staff to use sustainable modes of transport such as walking, cycling or public transport.

The school could organise car-free days or theme weeks dedicated to sustainable transport and provide information on safe walking or cycling routes to school.
